Traditional Stations of the Cross

- 1. Jesus is condemned to death.
- 2. Jesus is made to carry the cross.
- 3. Jesus falls for the first time.
- 4. Jesus meets his mother.*
- 5. Simon helps Jesus carry the cross.
- 6. Veronica wipes Jesus' face.*
- 7. Jesus falls the second time.
- 8. Jesus speaks to the mourning women of Jerusalem.
- 9. Jesus falls the third time.
- 10. Jesus is stripped of his garments.
- 11. Jesus is nailed to the cross.
- 12. Jesus dies on the cross.
- 13. The body of Jesus is taken down from the cross.
- 14. The body of Jesus is laid in the tomb.

The Scriptural Stations of the Cross

- 1. Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane.
- 2. Jesus, betrayed by Judas, is arrested.
- 3. Jesus is condemned by the Sanhedrin.
- 4. Jesus is denied by Peter.
- 5. Jesus is judged by Pilate.
- 6. Jesus is scourged and crowned with thorns.
- 7. Jesus bears the cross.
- 8. Jesus is helped by Simon of Cyrene to carry the cross.
- 9. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem.
- 10. Jesus is crucified.
- 11. Jesus promises his kingdom to the good thief.
- 12. Jesus speaks to his mother and the disciple.
- 13. Jesus dies on the cross.
- 14. Jesus is placed in the tomb.
