

Next Sunday's Worship - November 10, 25th Sunday after Pentecost

1 Kings 7:8-16, *Mark 12:38-44; "A Morsel of Bread"

Jesus and his disciples were people-watching near the temple treasury in Jerusalem when Jesus saw a poor widow put two small copper coins—all she had—into the collection box. Commenting on what he had just witnessed, Jesus exclaimed that her gift was greater than those of much wealthier contributors. Why? Because she had given all that she had. Her story resembles the Old Testament passage where the prophet Elijah asked a poor widow for a morsel of bread. Although it was all she had, she trusted that the Lord would provide if she fulfilled the prophet's request. What she received in return was more than she could ever have imagined.
