The transfiguration marks a turning point in Luke's gospel. Soon after his transfiguration—where his clothes become a dazzling white and he is joined by Moses and Elijah—Jesus, along with Peter, James, and John, rejoins the other disciples and comes upon a desperate scene. A man's son was tormented by a demon and the disciples were unable to heal him. Jesus addresses the situation, but not before lashing out at his disciples and the crowd in a fit of frustration. Why was Jesus so anxious? While the transfiguration offered a glimpse of his coming glory, it also revealed the painful path Jesus must take to get there.
